

Applying For A visitor Visa

Foreigners who come to Taiwan to study Chinese must submit the documents and pay the visa fee at the nearest **ROC embassy, consulate or representative agency** to apply for a **Visitor Visa for Studying Chinese Purpose**.

According to the policy of Ministry of Education of ROC, TaiSiHua can only enrolls students who are national of countries that eligible for the visa exemption program to ROC.

Application Procedure


Foreigners who come to Taiwan to study Chinese must submit the documents and pay the visa fee at the nearest **ROC embassy, consulate or representative agency**_to apply for a visitor visa.

Notices:

- Visas are issued as stipulated by Article 12 of the Statute Governing Issuance of ROC Visas for Foreign Passports. As a sovereign nation, the ROC has the right to refuse applications for visas without providing any explanation for such decisions; visa application fee is not refundable.
- 2. Foreign passport holders who had ever engaged in the jobs specified in items 8 to 10, paragraph 1, article 46 of Employment Services Act or who come from the " designated countries " (please refer to Procedures for Nationals of the Designated Countries Applying for Visitor Visas to the Republic of China (R.O.C.)) are not eligible for visitor visas for studying Chinese purpose.
- 3. Those who enter Taiwan under the visa-exemption program, with a landing visa or a visitor visa for other purposes than "studying Chinese" and those who have already resided in Taiwan for other purposes are **not eligible** for converting to a visa for the purpose of "studying Chinese" in Taiwan.
- 4. The original will be returned after processing. Those who cannot update documents within 2 weeks of being informed to do so will not have their visas issued and will not be returned their application fee.
- 5. Please refer to http://www.boca.gov.tw/ \rightarrow Visa \rightarrow visa fees for the information of application fees.
- 6. A certificate of admission issued by accredited language center does not guarantee visa issuance.
- 7. Foreigners coming to Taiwan as students with intention of learning Chinese Language are not allowed to work.
- 8. Be sure that you understand the rules and regulations regarding visas before you leave your country. For further details, contact the nearest Taiwan embassy, consulate or representative agency, or log on the following

Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, ROC (Taiwan)

• <u>Students who have to re-enter Taiwan during the term of study may</u> <u>apply for a multiple entry visa</u>. For those who hold a single-entry visa and would like to leave Taiwan during the period of study, please apply for a Certificate of Enrollment at TaiSiHua before leaving Taiwan, and be sure to apply for a new visa before entering Taiwan.

Visa Types:

- 1. Sixty days extendible: Visas bear no such remark as "no extension" may be extended twice for a maximum stay of up to 180 days. Please see the student hand book p.7 for visa extensions.
- 2. Non-extendible: Visas bear such remark as "no extension" may not apply for extension, unless his (her) request for changing to an extendable visa is approved by the Bureau of Consular Affairs.

3. Landing visa or visa-exemption: For those who entered Taiwan with a landing visa or visa –exemption cannot apply for an extension.

Non-extendible or when no further extensions will be granted, the holder must leave Taiwan for a short time. Student should pay close attention to the date stamped by customs upon entry into Taiwan.

Procedures for visa extensions

Students shall apply for a visa extension within 15days before the expiry date of their visitor visa in the local National Immigration Agency service center. The visa can be extended twice for a maximum stay of up to 180 days. Be sure to make a copy of your certificate of enrollment for the National Immigration Agency to keep.

Note that late applications for extending a visa are not acceptable. The applicant may have to pay a fine and take a trip off Taiwan to apply for the new visa.

Students who are absent for more than a quarter of total course hours are not allowed to extend visa.

Requirements:

- 1. The applicant who holds at least 60-day visitor visa remarked "FR" and without a stamp of no-extension.
- 2. The applicant shall apply for extension within 15days before the expiry date of their visitor visa (60 days from the next day of arrival).

Required documents:

- 1. An application form of visa extension.
- 2. Original and photocopied passport (the original will be returned after verification)
- 3. An enrollment of Private TaiSiHua Chinese/Foreign Language Short-Term Busiban.
- 4. An attendance record (The first time extension does not need to submit.)

Application method:

Can be done in person or applicant may authorize another person to represent them.

(In the case of authorizing a representative, applicant should fill out an authorized statement on the application form or attach a letter of authorization.)

Notices:

- 1. Foreigners who authorize an agent shall submit an authorization statement on the application form or attach an authorization letter.
- 2. The period of stay is calculated from the following day after entry.
- 3. Each extension must not exceed the originally permitted time on the visa. The cumulative length of stay must not exceed 180 days.
- 4. Those who expect the cumulative length of stay to exceed 180 days in case of force majeure or other major events should apply for an extension in advance at the local service center of the National Immigration Agency.

Admissions for students residing in the country

Foreigners who entered the country by themselves are not eligible for the aforementioned regulations.
